Meeting called to order by Supervisor VanVolkinburg at 6:30 p.m.
Pledge of Allegiance was led by Jim Stein.

Roll Call: All present – Roger VanVolkinburg, Matt Miner, Jim Stein, Sue Kamyszek and Ann McInerney.

Approval of October 1, meeting minutes with changes and closed meeting minutes as presented with a motion from Miner and support from Stein. Motion discussed, voted on; all yes, motion carried.
