# **Curbside Recycling Service**



Service is bi-weekly and split into zones. North of 129th and South of 129th

Please remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.



- 1. Rinse All Containers.
- 2. Leave caps on containers.
- Break down cardboard boxes.
- 4. Check for recycling symbol and number on plastic material.
- 5. Respect recycling station and property.
- 6. Follow all guidelines.



- No items with any
  food or soiled material in
  recycling container.
- 2. No Hazardous Waste in recycling. (engine oil, pesticide, paint, etc.)
- 3. No large plastic items in recycling. (plastic lawn chairs, five gallon bucket, etc.).
- 4. No Clothes.

NO STYROFOAM!

Wayland Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery at (269) 686-4559.

### Regional Recycling Depots:

You must bring your Resource Recovery Card!

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle tires (4), Styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

The following locations are open the \*1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb):

1) \*Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street, (located on 29th St South of 142nd Ave.)

open from 8:30am-3:30pm. (\$2/TV recycling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)

- 2) \*Allied Waste/Republic Recycling Station, 3310 M-40 Hwy, Hamilton, open 9am-12noon.
- 3) Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, visit www.barecycling.com for business hours.

## **Recycling Services**

Appliances (2 Appliances Annually.) (Appliances that are accepted are: Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Microwaves, Freezers, Stoves, Washing Machines and Dryers, Dehumidifiers, Dishwashers, Water Heaters, and Furnaces.)

Batteries

Metal Scrap Items (Inc. Gas Grills)

Styrofoam (No Packaging Peanuts, No construction foam. Place in a clear plastic bag.)

Tires (4 Car Tires or 1 Large Tire Annually.)

Cardboard, Paper Bags, Paper, Magazines & Newspaper

Glass Bottles (Clear, Brown, Green)

Plastic Bottles (Recycling symbol #1-#7.)

Plastic#2 & #4 Bags (grocery bags.)

Tin/Steel & Aluminum Cans

Material must be clean.

### Resource Recovery Card

Residents must present their resource recovery card to manager. Cards available at the twp. hall.
