Wayland Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery (269) 686-4559.



- South of 129th


Residents may contact Republic Services at (877) 698-7274 to report a missed pickup.

- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
