### Recycling Information

Wayland Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery (269) 673-5411.

#### What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



Obey the guidelines!

Contaminated recycling ends up in landfills and increases overall recycling costs.

### Regional Recycling Depots:

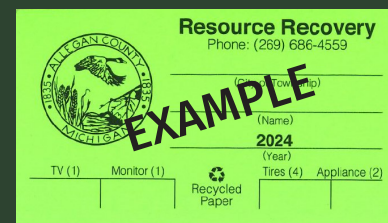
Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)

## 2025 UPDATE

Beginning with the winter tax bills that will be sent out in December, the recycling surcharge will increase from \$25 per household per year to \$50 per household per year. This was voted on and passed during the August 2024 election. These additional surcharge funds will continue to maintain curbside recycling for the community. Any additional funds will be allocated towards resident participation at community recycling events and at depot site drop-offs for recycling televisions, computer monitors, tires, and appliances.
