### What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property

Contaminated recycling ends up in landfills and increases overall recycling costs.


### Regional Recycling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)

- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, is open Tuesday-Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. Visit [www.recyclingisba.com](http://www.recyclingisba.com) for more information.
